

Hohman and Associates - Field Botanist Position

Hohman and Associates has a part-time opening for an entry-level Field Botanist. The preferred candidate will have a degree in Botany or a related field, and a strong background in identifying common and rare plants in the North Coast region of California. Primary duties would include navigating rugged terrain to survey for special-status plants, sight-identifying plants in the field, using a dichotomous key, and data entry. The field botanist will work under the supervision of the lead Botanist/Biologist. Additional opportunities to work on mapping, reporting, vegetation assessments, and biological work may be available to qualified candidates. Applicants should be available for all-day surveys at least two to three days out of the work week.

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- A Bachelor's degree in Botany or a similar field with related coursework such as Plant Taxonomy or Field Botany
- Familiarity with Northern California flora and plant ecology
- Experience identifying plant species in the field
- Experience navigating by GPS, maps, and compass
- Proficient with word processing and spreadsheet software
- Have a valid driving license with a clean driving record
- Safely drive an ATV and navigate in remote locations
- Good critical thinking and communication skills
